

Dear Resident of the Wight Street Neighborhood:

During the past year, the City of Belfast has been considering conducting an infrastructure improvement project for the entire length of Wight Street and for an adjacent section of Congress Street, and has been seeking grant funding to pay for these proposed infrastructure improvements. The primary improvements that are being considered for Wight Street include reconstructing its road base, installing one sidewalk, installing storm drainage, installing curbing, installing pedestrian crossings, installing bicycle lanes, and incorporating traffic calming measures. The primary improvement that is being considered for Congress Street is an extension of the sewer line.



The City of Belfast has recently been awarded grant funding that will be sufficient to implement this project and is getting ready to begin the design process. As a critical, initial part of that process, the City wants to know what you, as a resident of the neighborhood where these improvements are going to be made, have for suggestions, comments, and other input regarding this project. To that end, the Belfast City Council will be holding a Public Listening Session on **Monday, June 27th, 2022, from 6:00pm to 8:00pm, at the Waldo County Shrine Club, located at 20 Northport Avenue in Belfast.** We hope that you will be able to attend and participate. No registration for this listening session is required, and we encourage you to bring with you any other members of the public who may be interested in this project.
